This guide lists outlets within Callaway County for many items that can be recycled.


- **Please Call First.** There may be specific requirements or fees regarding the items accepted.

Rechargeable Battery Tips

1. Follow the manufacturer's instructions. There are specific charging recommendations for each product prior to use.
2. Never return a fully-charged battery to the charger for an extra boost. This will actually shorten the life of the battery.
3. Do not leave your rechargeable battery in the charger when not charging.
4. Let a discharged battery cool to room temperature before recharging.
5. Recharge batteries only when they are near to fully discharged.
6. When they no longer hold a charge and it's time to buy a replacement rechargeable battery, make sure to recycle your old one!



Have Medicine?

DO NOT FLUSH!!!!

1. Place the contents in a large plastic container (detergent or soda bottle)
 2. Put a small amount of water in to dissolve the medicine
 3. Add a thickening agent (flour, saw dust, cat litter etc.)
 4. Recap and seal with duct tape - Place in trash just prior to pick up
- *Blister packs - wrap in duct tape, place in plastic bottle and seal again with duct tape

What kind of plastic is it?

Is it Plastic Film?

Can you ball it up like paper? It is film, another name for plastic bags. No matter what the bag says, or the number printed on it, plastic shopping bags (film) can only be recycled with other plastic film. This type of material is usually collected by grocery stores and should not be recycled with other types of plastics.

Not Film? What number is it?

There are many different types of plastics used to make containers; some are easier to recycle than others. These differences mean that communities can only recycle certain types of plastic. The type of plastic is usually marked on the bottom of the container and looks like this:



or



The presence of this symbol does not mean that the container can be recycled in your community. The number in the center is the key. Contact your recycler to find out which numbers they recycle.

Hint:

Lids to containers are usually a different type of plastic. Check the lids for their own number.

Plastic Facts

- Americans use 2,500,000 plastic bottles every hour. Most of them are thrown away.
- Plastic bags and other plastic garbage thrown into the ocean kill as many as 1,000,000 sea creatures every year.
- Recycling plastic saves twice as much energy as burning it in an incinerator.
- Americans throw away 25,000,000,000 Styrofoam coffee cups every year.
