

CITY COUNCIL MINUTES
May 20, 2014

The Council of the City of Fulton, Missouri, met in Special Session at 6:30 p.m. on Tuesday, May 20, 2014 in the Council Chambers located in City Hall, 18 E. 4th Street, Fulton, Missouri. Present and presiding were LeRoy D. Benton, Mayor; Carolyn L. Laswell, City Clerk; and Steve Myers, Chief of Police. The meeting was called to order by Mayor Benton at 6:30 p.m. On roll call the members of the Council present were Chailland; Moore; Rehklau; Shiverdecker; Vaughn; and West. Absent were councilmembers Cannel and Pace.

The City Clerk read the Reading of Call.

SUBJECT OF DISCUSSION:

Bill No. 1403 was presented for Second Reading and read by Councilman West.

BILL NO. 1403 - An Ordinance Imposing a Use Tax for General Revenue Purposes at the rate of 2% pursuant to the authority granted by and subject to the provisions of Sections 144.600 through 144.761 RSMO; providing for the Use Tax to be Repealed, Reduced or Raised; and Providing for as any City Sales Tax is Repealed, Reduced or Raised; and providing for Submission of the Proposal to the qualified Voters of the City for their approval at the Primary Election called and to be held in the City on Tuesday, August 5, 2014 (Copy is included in the official Ordinance Book).

Motion was offered by Councilman West and seconded by Councilman Shiverdecker to place Bill No. 1403 for Third Reading at this council meeting. Motion carried with six members of the council voting in favor and two members (Cannell and Pace)) absent.

Bill No. 1403 was read for the third time by Councilman West.

Motion was offered by Councilman West and seconded by Councilman Chailland to place Bill No. 1403 for Final Passage at this council meeting. Motion carried with six members of the council voting in favor and two members (Cannell and Pace)) absent.

Roll call vote of members of the council were as follows: Chailland, yes; Moore, yes; Rehklau, yes; Shiverdecker, yes; Vaughn, yes; and West, yes. Bill No 1403 having received the affirmative vote of six members of the council, two members (Cannell and Pace) absent, was
