

# Fulton Water Works Rules & Regulations



1. Splash Pad operating hours are Monday-Sunday, 11:00 am - 9:00 pm.
2. Splash pad operating season: May 1—October 1, depending on weather.
3. All persons using splash pad, do so at their own risk. No lifeguard on duty.
4. All children under 11 years of age must have adult supervision at all times.
5. The water in splash pad re-circulates; so for your safety, do not drink the water.
6. Street shoes are not allowed on splash pad.
7. No running, rough play or foul language allowed.
8. Infants must wear swim diapers. Please do not change diapers on splash pad.
9. Persons with open cuts or sores, infection or diseases that may be transmitted by the water are prohibited.
10. Animals are not allowed on or near splash pad.
11. Glass bottles are not allowed on or near splash pad.
12. Smoking on or near the splash pad is prohibited.
13. No food or drinks are allowed on the splash pad.
14. Do not cover water fixtures or drains.
15. Do not climb on splash pad equipment, benches or tables.
16. Skateboards, Bikes or Rollerblades are not allowed on the splash pad.
17. Do not use splash pad during severe weather conditions.
18. Electrical appliances or cords are not allowed within 10 feet of the splash pad.
19. Splash pad may be closed at any time due to maintenance or other issues.
20. Any person violating the rules and regulations may be evicted from the park.
21. Water balloons are prohibited in or around the splash.
