

**CITY COUNCIL MINUTES**  
**JANUARY 29, 2019**

The Council of the City of Fulton, Missouri, met in Special Session on Tuesday, January 29, 2019 in the Council Chambers of City Hall located at 18 E. 4th Street. Present and presiding were: Steve Moore, Deputy Mayor; William R. Johnson, Director of Administration; and Courtney L. Crowson, City Clerk. The meeting was called to order by Deputy Mayor Moore at 5:30 p.m. Roll call was taken by the City Clerk, and members of the council present were: Braun, Chailland, Moore, Rehkla, Shiverdecker, Simmons, and Stone. Absent was Councilman Vaughn. Also present were: Kevin Coffelt, Fire Chief; and Michelle Maupin, Human Resources Director.
