- Report from Kingdom Pilot's Association (KPA)
  - Courtesy Car was brought up and got a picture of Stockton's car with insurance. David H mentioned that he has driven an individual in to town recently. Then Daniel stated that he got a lot of calls about a car.
  - David H asked about the fuel and what all cards does it take. Someone tried to use avfuel card.

- Report from City- Kyle Bruemmer
  - Finance Report- Kyle brought a packet with the Airport fuel and hangar for increasing revenue and what options he was looking at.
  - Fuel- According to Daniel, during the Oshkosh Event, the airport sold over 5,000 gallons of fuel.
  - Hangar- The Idea was brought up to raise the hangar price from 13 cents to 15 cents per square foot. In addition, asked about raising the rate for ground lease since someone is interested in a ground lease and the current ground lease is up for rate review this year. In addition, Kyle mentioned that the City Council approved for JAviation to work on hangars. Also, Kyle mentioned that he put in the application to update the reil lights on Runway 18-36.

  - Daniel mentioned that there was an incident at the airport least Thursday and no injuries were reported, some grass missing from the side but not much, and some damage to the plane which is not in any condition to fly. In addition, Daniel reported that there were two lights burned out since last meeting and the sign out front had been fixed. However, Steve saw that it was fixed and already sent a picture of the sign replace to Mrs. Hensley. Next, Daniel mentioned that he would like to start getting some of the cracks filled in along with some of the vegetation growing in a few areas, mowed down when possible. Lastly, Daniel stated that he just got the pump nozzle tightened right before the meeting and should let him know if it starts to leak again or continues to leak.
