REPORT FROM KINGDOM PILOTS ASSOCIATION

Pancake Fly-In fund raiser scheduled tentatively for September 19th was cancelled and rescheduled for March 15th, 2021. KPA is distributing Covid masks around the state. These masks were received from The State of Missouri Exercise Tiger Foundation and there are articles in the Missourian and Fulton Sun reporting the activities. KPA also reported they received \$775 from the Elton Hensley Family Memorial to be donated to towards its scholarship fund. No active NOTAMS for the Elton Hensley Memorial Airport.

REPORT FROM CITY ENGINEER'S OFFICE

- 1. PAPI Light Project Update:** The PAPI lights on 18-36 have been fixed. We have replaced the circuit board and radio. We have also increased the sensitivity.
- 2. Hangar Project Update:** City of Fulton will be handling the construction management of the job. Verslues Construction has begun some work. The engineered steel building is scheduled to arrive mid-October. It is the contractor's intent to first build the taxiway and the floor of the hangar while weather is still warm and then move to building erection in the colder months.
- 3. Open Discussion:** Mowing between the runways was discussed. Mike reported the City boom mower needed repair and we will be addressing the issue soon. Additionally, if dry weather prevails we could possibly get some of the weeds with the batwing mower.

- 1. Safety and Maintenance Items:** We have been diligently working to repair our light issues.
- 2. Fuel:** Fuel tank has 5700 gallons of Low Lead 100 priced at \$3.49.
