The Council of the City of Fulton, Missouri, met in Regular Session on Tuesday, May 15, 2023, at 7:00 p.m. in the Council Chambers of City Hall located at 18 E. 4th Street. Motion was offered by Councilwoman Sebacher and Seconded by Councilwoman Nelson to adopt Resolution No. 3491 at tonight's Council meeting. Motion carried with five members of the Council voting in favor and three members absent (Combs, Hinchie, and Rehklau).

Resolution No. 3492: Lead Service Line Replacement Funding Grant

A Resolution authorizing the Mayor, on behalf of the City of Fulton, Missouri, to make application and sign all necessary documents with the Missouri Department of Natural Resources, State Revolving Fund Program for loans under the Missouri Clean Water Law (Chapter 640, RSMo).

Motion was offered by Councilman Stone and Seconded by Councilwoman Sebacher to adopt Resolution No. 3492 at tonight's Council meeting. Motion carried with five members of the Council voting in favor and three members absent (Combs, Hinchie, and Rehklau).

Resolution No. 3493 was presented for adoption by Councilman Leuther.

Resolution No. 3493: Authorization for Firetruck Purchase

A Resolution authorizing the Mayor, on behalf of the City of Fulton, Missouri, to sign all necessary documents in relation to an agreement with Banner Fire Equipment to build an E-One Rescue Pumper to meet the specific needs for the City of Fulton Fire Department.

Motion was offered by Councilman Leuther and Seconded by Councilwoman Sebacher to adopt Resolution No. 3493 at tonight's Council meeting. Motion carried with five members of the Council voting in favor and three members absent (Combs, Hinchie, and Rehklau).

Bill No. 1678: Callaway County Tax Collection Agreement

An Ordinance authorizing the Mayor and the City Clerk, on behalf of the City of Fulton, Missouri, to sign all necessary documents in relation to a contract with the Collector and County Commissioners of Callaway County, Missouri, relating to the collection of taxes with the Contract period commencing upon approval through June, 2027.

Motion was offered by Councilwoman Nelson and seconded by Councilman Stone to place Bill No. 1678 for Second Reading at the next regularly-scheduled Council meeting. Motion carried with five members of the Council voting in favor and three members absent (Combs, Hinchie, and Rehklau).

Bill No. 1679 was presented for First Reading by Councilman Stone

Bill No. 1679: Rename E. 13th Street to Ovid Bell Street

An Ordinance renaming E. 13th Street to Ovid Bell Street and establishing an effective date.

Motion was offered by Councilman Stone and seconded by Councilwoman Sebacher to place Bill No. 1679 for Second Reading at the next regularly-scheduled Council meeting. Motion carried with five members of the Council voting in favor and three members absent (Combs, Hinchie, and Rehklau).

Bill No. 1677: The Accepting of Donations, Gifts and Sponsorships

An Ordinance amending Chapter 2, Administration, Article VI., Finances, Purchasing, and Bid Procedures of the Fulton City Code, by adding Sections 2-371 through 2-375, the Accepting of Donations, Gifts and Sponsorships, and establishing an effective date.

Motion was offered by Councilwoman Nelson and Seconded by Councilwoman Sebacher to place Bill No. 1677 for Third and Final Reading at the next regularly-scheduled Council meeting. Motion carried with five members of the Council voting in favor and three members absent (Combs, Hinchie, and Rehklau).
